READ

- Hebrews 1:1-4
- Isaiah 44:24
- John 1:14
- Acts 17:26-28

RESPOND

Question 1. God has opened himself up for all to know Him. He has given us His word to understand Him. Knowing that God loves us and wants to know us, how does this change our understanding of God?

Question 2. Francis Schaeffer writes "He (God) is there and he is not silent" Looking at today's scripture passages, what is God saying?

Question 3. When the Apostle Paul was in Athens he found an altar with the inscription: "to an unknown god." Do you think that people are looking for God today? Where do we see the signs of God in our culture?

Question 4. One of the most important questions we can ask ourselves is who is God? How would you explain who God is in very simple words?

Question 5. Every human being has been created to reflect the nature of God. We discover who we are when we discover who God is. How do you think that you reflect God throughout your life, your words and your actions?

PRAY

Pray that in your walk with God, you would be revealed more to who God is and what He thinks of you.

REFLECT

In the past God spoke to our ancestors through the prophets at many times and in various ways, 2 but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom also he made the universe. 3 The Son is the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of his being, sustaining all things by his powerful word. After he had provided purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty in heaven. 4 So he became as much superior to the angels as the name he has inherited is superior to theirs.
